### Why do municipal elections matter?

# 1) The gay agenda to transform the fabric of society with respect to family and marriage, has now shifted to the educational system. Already, curriculum is being prepared to teach our children that the traditional 'family' is just one option amongst many equivalent models, including homosexual ones. By electing pro-marriage individuals as school trustees, we'll be able to resist the gay agenda. This is especially important since Ontario Premier Dalton McGuinty, appointed in early September the open lesbian (and gay activist) Kathleen Wynne, MPP for Don West, as our new Minister of Education. We need strong advocates within the school board to defend parental rights.
